Command Flow: Commands are presented in dialog boxes that are organized by workflow, allowing you to work from top to bottom to complete the command. A **red asterisk** marks steps that require some selection. A **green check** mark replaces the asterisk once you have selected a suitable object.

An **orange highlight** indicates the current active selection. A **green highlight** indicates the next recommended step. You can click the middle mouse button (MB2) to go to the next step. Once you provide all the required inputs, the **OK** or **Apply** buttons are highlighted in green and clicking MB2 acts as OK.

Most command dialog boxes have the **OK**, **Apply** and **Cancel** confirmation buttons. Click **OK** to complete the command and close the dialog box. Click **Apply** to complete the command but leave the dialog box open. Click **Cancel** to close the dialog box without completing the command.

Some commands are optimized to make the necessary selections. The example is dimension creation.
