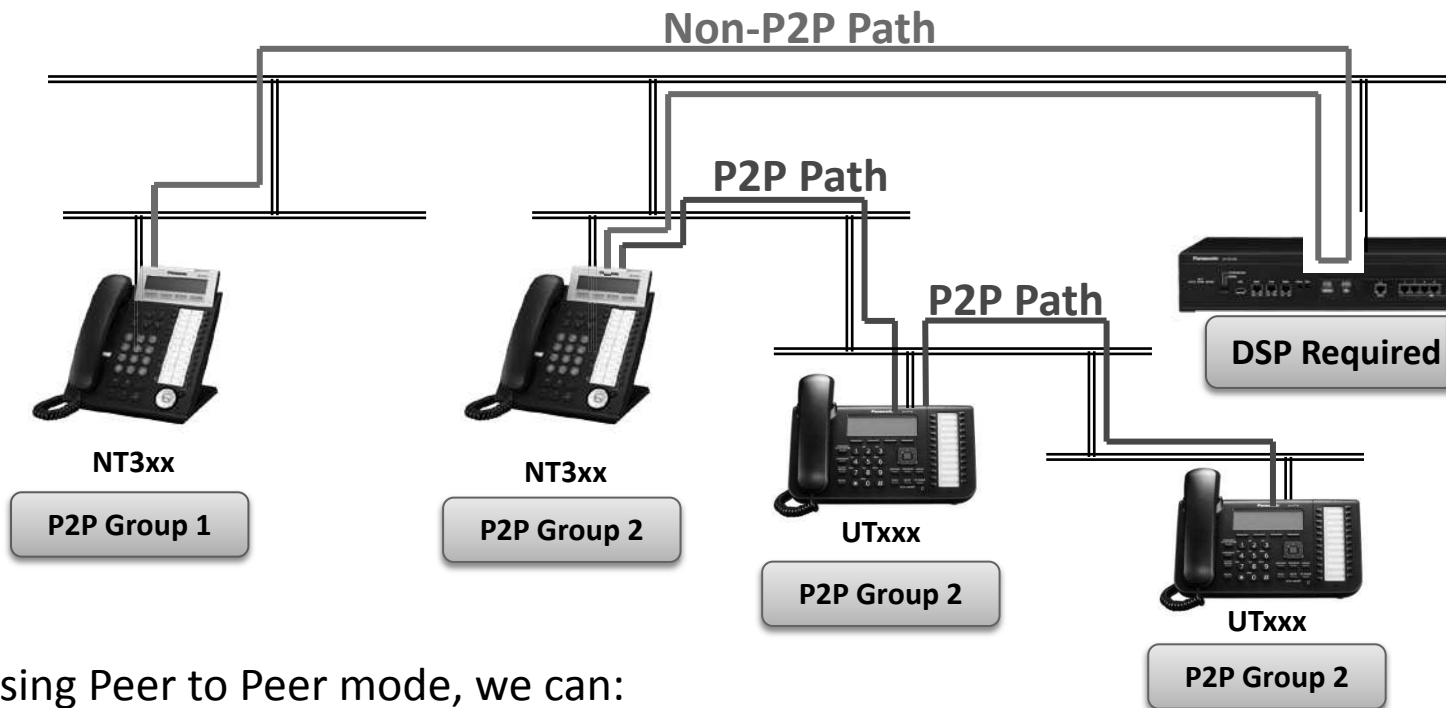


4-1. Peer to Peer (P2P) Commun

Peer to Peer (P2P) Communications.

The NS1000 automatically establishes peer-to-peer communication between peer-to-peer compatible IP extensions (i.e., NT3xx and UT series) that belong to the same P2P group.

Non P2P Calls require DSP Resource.



By using Peer to Peer mode, we can:

- Potentially reduce network wide traffic to the PBX
- Improve voice quality for P2P calls (By using G722 codec – Only supported

Note: P2P cannot be disabled but, using P2P Group function, phones assigned to different P2P Group can make

**'Settings' -> PBX Configuration -> Slot
-> Virtual Cards -> Port Properties**

The P2P Group extension

NB: IP-CS do not support P2P communication, so no P2P Group setting is available for IP-CS.
